
COVID 19 RE-OPENING OF FACILITIES

Government guidance has now been issued that allows community buildings and play equipment to re-open from Saturday 4 July.

Brockworth Parish Council has followed this advice and undertaken risk assessments to establish how and when we can safely re-open our facilities.

Brockworth Community Centre

The Community Centre will be open to the public from Monday 6 July for access to Parish Council services, reception, toilets and the sale of dog bags ONLY.

The café will remain closed until government guidance changes.

Many of the activities that take place at the community centre are not allowed to re-open yet, so we are not allowed to open for our usual classes and groups. We will let you know when the situation changes and look forward to when we can welcome you back.

Play areas, MUGA's and adult exercise equipment

Brockworth Parish Council plans to re-open its play areas and exercise equipment next week once we can put in place the appropriate safety measures and signage. Until then the play areas, MUGA's and adult exercise equipment remains closed and should not be used.

We will notify the community when these facilities have re-opened and the steps you need to take to safely use them.

When visiting our facilities, users will be asked to:

- Maintain safe social distancing at all times
- Wash your hands before and after using equipment
- Clean down equipment before and after using it
- Avoid touching your face with your hands
- If sites are busy, please come back when they are quieter
- Not eat or drink in the play areas and to take your litter home
- Not use our facilities if you (or anyone in your household) are symptomatic and to self isolate and get tested
- Usage of our facilities is at your own risk
