19/PHE HIGHWAYS MATTERS

1. The meeting received an email from a resident regarding the increase in traffic on various roads. The meeting discussed the issues and the build-up of traffic and reasons for this. A letter would need to go out to residents informing them that Highways needed to be contacted with traffic concerns with a copy of the council's strategy. **Action Clerk**
2. The meeting received and discussed a letter from a resident regarding the lowering of the speed restriction in Brockworth to 20mph. The meeting discussed the advantages and disadvantages of reducing the speed around Brockworth. The Assistant Clerk asked the chairman for permission to speak and attempted to advise the meeting of the procedure that would need to be followed. 20/PHE ENVIRONMENT MATTERS

1. The meeting discussed the fly tipping on the private road behind the Court Road Shops. The mattress needed to be reported to Tewkesbury Borough Council. A standard letter needed to be produced to send to affected areas. This letter needed to remind residents that it is a criminal offence to fly tip and what costs were incurred when dealing with fly tipping. **Action Clerk**
2. The meeting discussed an email from a resident regarding Mill Lane Playing Field having handouts regarding dog fouling. The environmental health officers from Tewkesbury Borough Council attended Mill Lane Playing field to hand out flyers and it was agreed that their timing was bad.
