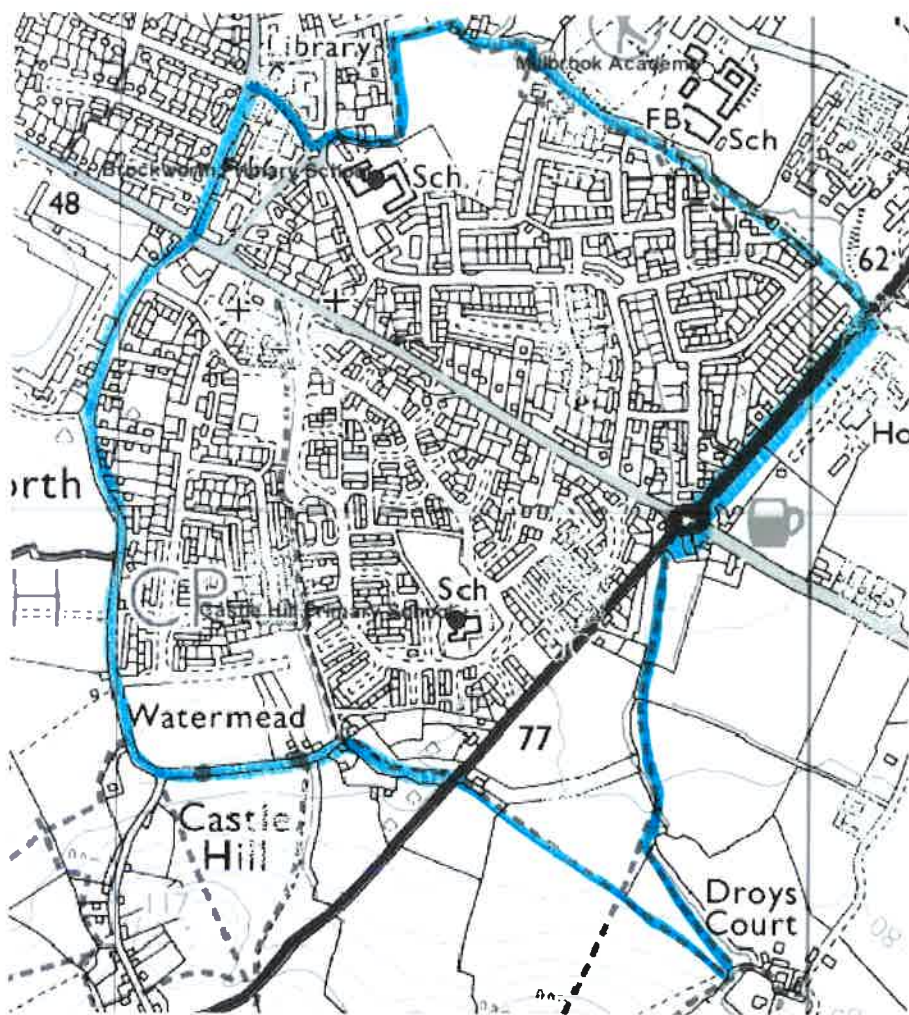


CIRCULAR WALKS IN BROCKWORTH PARISH - WALK #2

Please observe the Country Code:

- *Fasten all gates*
- *Keep dogs under proper control*
- *Take your litter home with you*
- *Guard against starting fires*
- *Keep to public footpaths*
- *Protect wildlife, plants and trees*
- *Avoid damaging fences, hedges or wall.*

This circular walk takes you along Horsbere Brook and out to the south. The total distance is approximately 3 miles and is a fairly level, easy walk that takes approximately 1.5 hours to complete. This walk is not pushchair/buggy friendly due to the kissing gates and muddy sections of the walk.

Start at Brockworth Community Centre, where there are toilets and refreshment facilities available Monday to Friday 9am to 4pm.

The Route:

From the community centre on Court Road, turn left into Court Road and down towards Ermin Street. Cross Ermin Street into Green Street and follow Green Street until you come to Watermead on your left. Follow Watermead to the kissing gate in front of you, go through this and follow the path across the old orchard until you reach the A46 road. Carefully cross the road and go over the 2 stiles to the right of the house which is on your left. Follow the path across the large field, bearing to your left when you reach another kissing gate in a fence, follow this footpath to another kissing gate in the corner of the field. Going through the kissing gate follow the path to the left, through another gate into Cross Hands Meadow (behind the petrol station). Cross the roundabout and follow Shurdington Road until you reach Horsbere Brook which is opposite the Brockworth garden centre. Cross the road to the left and follow the brook until you reach the Mill Lane playing field. Walk around the outskirts until you reach the alleyway in the corner and follow the alleyway alongside the school back into Vicarage Road. Cross the road and walk past the War Memorial then turn right onto Moorfield Road back to the community centre.
